



Pre-Kindergarten Financial Assistance Program

How does the financial assistance program work?

- The program will offer approved families financial assistance based on eligibility for the program.
- The amount is dependent upon household income.
- The amount distributed will be decided by the School Board committee, which will be a matching of funds, or funding up to 100% coverage for extreme need.

Who is eligible for the financial assistance program?

- Families that are in need of financial assistance in order for their child to attend pre-kindergarten classes are encouraged to notify Mr. Macord Johnson, Principal, or the PLS secretary, of their interest in financial assistance.
- Approval will be made based on the need for the enrolled pre-kindergarten student (s). All information provided is confidential.
- The School Board will use the current year's income guidelines provided by the State of Minnesota for the Free & Reduced Lunch program to determine eligibility for the assistance.

Who is responsible for making decisions in regards the program?

- 3 School Board members will be elected to this committee.

Where do the funds come from?

- An anonymous donor has granted funds to be used by enrolled students in the PLS pre-kindergarten program.

What is the financial assistance money used for?

- The financial assistance will be applied to cover pre-kindergarten tuition and materials.

What is the review period for the program?

- Applications are reviewed at the October and February School Board meetings, and other months based on need.
- The program rules and committee responsibilities will be reviewed annually, by the School Board.
