Financial Assistance Match Program Information

How does the financial assistance program work?

- The program will offer approved families a financial assistance “dollar for dollar match” of up to \$500.00 per school year.
- The match amount is dependent upon household income.
 - Families who fall under the income guidelines for free lunches are eligible for a match of up to \$500.00.
 - Families who fall under the income guidelines for reduced lunches are eligible for a match of up to \$250.00.

Who is eligible for the financial assistance match program?

- ***All interested/eligible families are encouraged to notify Macord Johnson, Principal, or Sally Kiecker Secretary, of their interest in the program.***
- Approval will be made per family/household (not per student).
- The school board will use the current year’s income guidelines provided by the State of Minnesota for the Free & Reduced Lunch program.

Who is responsible for making decisions in regards the program?

- 3 School Board members will be elected to this committee.

Where do the funds come from?

- The initial amount will be paid by the family.
- The matched amount comes from the income (earned interest) of the Endowment Fund, at Thrivent Financial.

What is the financial assistance money used for?

- The matched amount can be used for any cost at school (i.e. registration fees, hot lunch fees, milk fees, etc.)
- The financial assistance match will be applied as a credit to the family’s statement, after the initial payment from the family has been received.

What is the review period for the program?

- The program rules and committee responsibly will be reviewed annually, by the School Board.
